The Annex Tree Tour set for Saturday starting at 2 pm is part of Toronto Tree Tours. The two-hour outing is free, but you need to register.

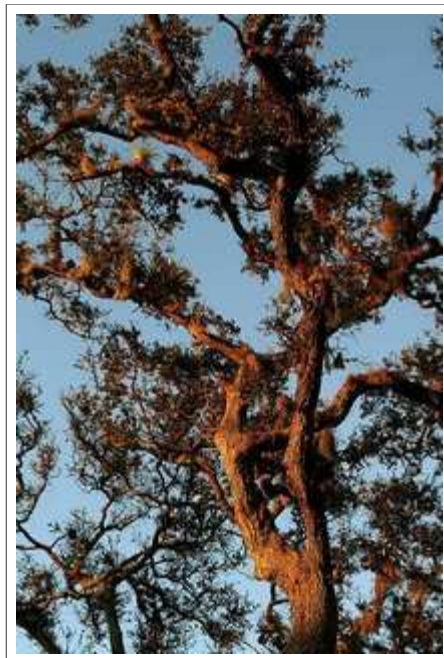
Things get underway at the northwest corner of College & Spadina, where you meet up with the guide, arborist Todd Irvine. Highlights of the tour include:

- * an ancient white oak—thought to be one of the largest in the city—growing just steps away from one of Toronto's busiest streets.

- * wandering down back alleys to discover hidden giants, including a 70-foot-tall bur oak.

- * venturing into the past as you gaze down a tree-lined boulevard onto St. Stephen's in the Field, a 150-year-old Victorian Gothic style church that was once surrounded by gardens and grasslands.

Members of the Harbord Village Residents Association and The Annex Residents Association will be there to share stories about helping the forest canopy in their neighbourhoods.
