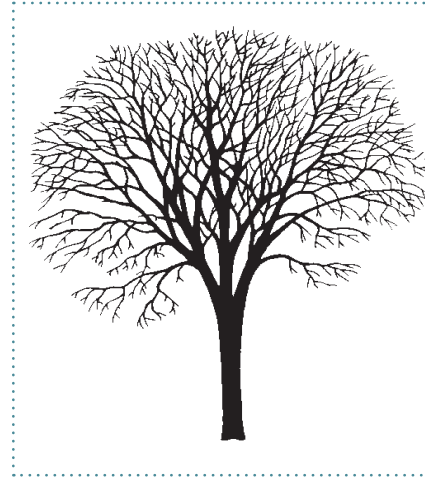

FORM

HEIGHT 50 feet
WIDTH 50 feet

vase shaped, broad, rounded crown with arching limbs and drooping branches

LEAF

simple, light green, oblong to elliptical with serrate edges; emerge in spring

FALL COLOUR

yellow

BARK

smooth, spongy, reddish-brown when young; deeply fissured, dark ash grey when mature

FLOWER

small, green, non-showy, drooping clusters; emerge in early spring before leaves

FRUIT

small, greenish-yellow, round, flat, papery-like samaras containing single seeds; mature in early summer
