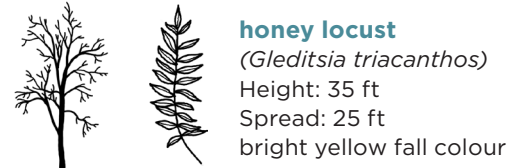

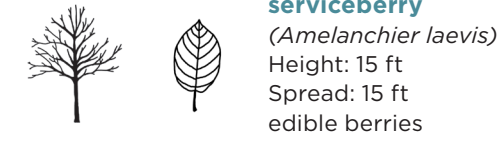

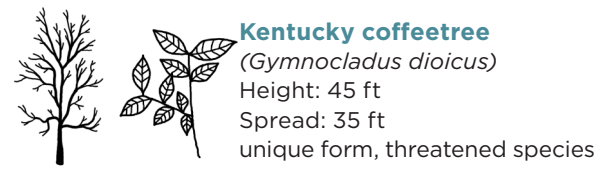

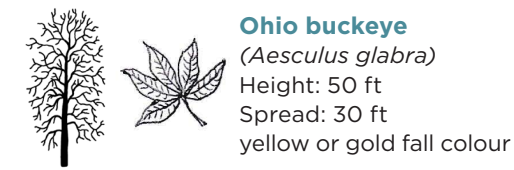

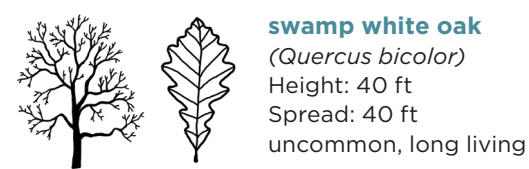

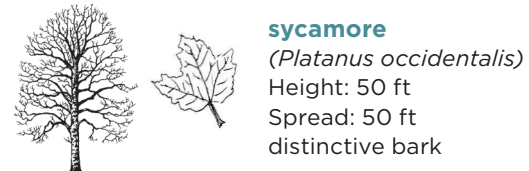
**pagoda dogwood**

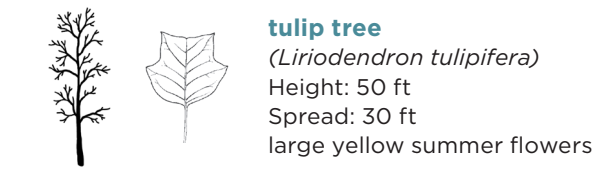
