COMMON NINEBARK



MATURE FORM

JUST PLANTED





WIDTH 6 feet upright, rounded to irregular crown with dense, widespreading, arching branches

HEIGHT 6 feet



LEAF

simple, green to yellow, 3-5 shallow lobes (maple-like), ovate to rounded with serrate edges; emerge in spring



FALL COLOUR

yellow





FLOWER

small, white, five-petaled, dense, round clusters; emerge in late spring



FRUIT

small, pinkish-red, drooping clusters of inflated, papery seed capsules; mature in early summer and sometimes persist throughout the winter



BARK

smooth, shiny, reddishbrown when young; brown, exfoliating and peeling in strips to reveal reddish-brown inner bark when mature
