COMMON WITCHHAZEL



MATURE FORM

JUST PLANTED





HEIGHT 15 feet **WIDTH** 15 feet

tall, irregular, open crown with many large, spreading branches



LEAF

simple, medium to dark green above and paler green below, oval to obovate with large, wavy edges



FALL COLOUR

beautiful shades of yellow





FLOWER

small, bright yellow, fragrant, slender, crinkly, ribbon-like petals appearing in clusters along branches; emerge in late fall and persist into the next fall, usually after leaf drop



FRUIT

small, tan to brown, woody seed capsules containing 1-2 black seeds; mature in late growing season



NEW LEAVES

leaves emerge in spring
