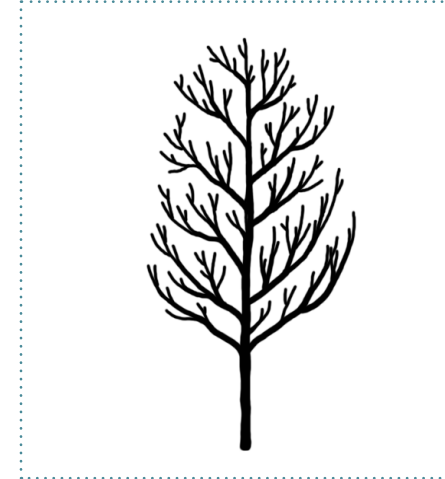

FORM

HEIGHT 40 feet
WIDTH 25 feet
oval to rounded crown with upright branches

LEAF

simple, green, rounded, 3-5 deep lobes (similar to silver maple) with smooth edges; emerge in spring

FALL COLOUR

brilliant shades of yellow to red

BARK

smooth, silvery-grey when young; slightly furrowed, darker grey when mature

FLOWER

small, red, round clusters; appear in early spring before the leaves

FRUIT

green to red, clusters of two-winged, papery, horseshoe-shaped samaras (called keys); mature in late spring/early summer; often limited in numbers
