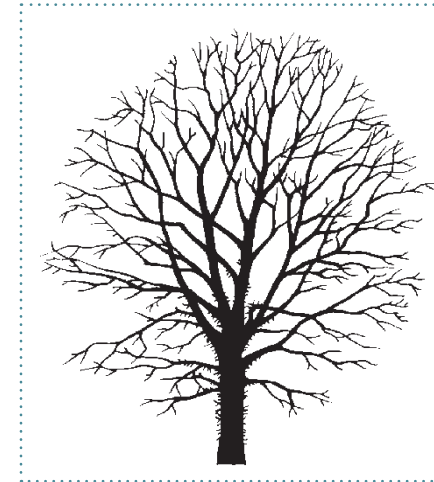

FORM

HEIGHT 35 feet
WIDTH 25 feet

very open, spreading crown, similar to a “typical” African savanna tree

LEAF

pinnately compound, yellowish-green, 15-30 elliptical leaflets with smooth edges (fern-like appearance); emerge in late spring

FALL COLOUR

bright yellow to orange

BARK

smooth, grey-brown when young; longitudinal ridges, dark grey-brown when mature

FLOWER

small, pale greenish-yellow, fragrant, long clusters; emerge in early summer

FRUIT

large, reddish-brown, flat, leathery, dry, twisted pods containing oval, dark brown seeds; mature in late summer/early fall and often persist into the winter
