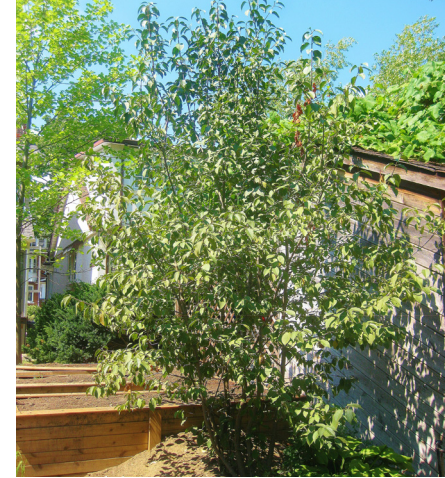

FORM

HEIGHT 15 feet
WIDTH 8 feet

open, irregular to rounded crown with upright branches

LEAF

simple, glossy, dark green, long, ovate with finely serrate edges; emerge in spring

FALL COLOUR

yellow to red to purple

FLOWER

small, white, non-fragrant, flat-topped clusters; emerge in late spring/early summer

FRUIT

small, bluish-black, oblong to round clusters of drupes containing single, small, stone-like, flat seeds and borne on red stalks

NEW FRUIT

mature in late summer/early fall and often persist into the winter
