
SILVER MAPLE



MATURE FORM

JUST PLANTED



FORM

HEIGHT 50 feet **WIDTH** 35 feet

oval to rounded crown with spreading to drooping branches



LEAF

simple, bright green above and silvery below, rounded, five deep lobes with coarsely serrate edges; emerge in spring



FALL COLOUR

bright yellow, sometimes red





BARK

smooth, silvery-grey when young; coarse, flaky, grey when mature



FLOWER

small, green to red, dense clusters; emerge in early spring before the leaves



FRUIT

large, green to reddish-brown, clusters of two-winged, papery, horseshoe-shaped samaras (called keys); mature in late spring/early summer
