HEIGHT 45 feet WIDTH 30 feet

rounded crown with spreading branches

LEAF

simple, dark green above and paler green below, rounded, five lobes with smooth edges; emerge in spring

FALL COLOUR

colour gradient from green to yellow to orange to red







smooth, light grey-brown when young; deeply furrowed with irregular ridges, dark grey when mature



FLOWER

small, yellow-green clusters hanging from long, slender stems; emerge in early spring before or with the leaves



FRUIT

small, green to brown, clusters of two-winged, horseshoe-shaped samaras (called keys); mature in fall
