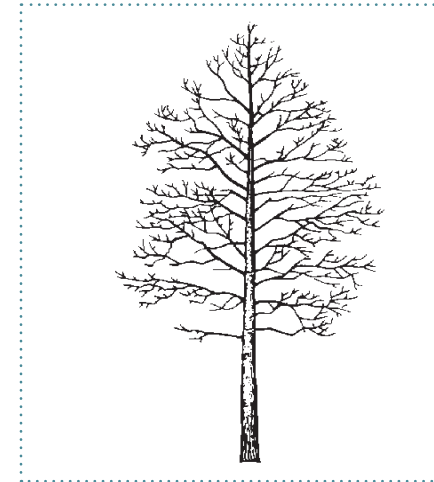

**FORM**

**HEIGHT** 50 feet  
**WIDTH** 50 feet

slender with a short, rounded crown; may spread if root suckers are not removed; often occurs in thickets

**LEAF**

simple, dark green above and paler green below, heart-shaped to rounded with finely toothed edges; emerge in spring

**FALL COLOUR**

golden yellow to orange

**BARK**

smooth, creamy white to light green when young; thick black furrows, waxy greenish-white to grey when mature

**FLOWER**

tiny, green, male catkins and large, female catkins; emerge in spring on separate trees

**FRUIT**

light green, long, capsules containing small, hairy, silky seeds that easily blow in the wind; mature late spring/early summer
