
TREMBLING ASPEN



MATURE FORM

JUST PLANTED



FORM

HEIGHT 50 feet WIDTH 50 feet

slender with a short, rounded crown; may spread if root suckers are not removed; often occurs in thickets

and paler green below, emerge in spring



BARK

smooth, creamy white to light green when young; thick black furrows, waxy greenish-white to grey when mature

tiny, green, male catkins and large, female catkins; emerge in spring on separate trees







LEAF

simple, dark green above heart-shaped to rounded with finely toothed edges;



golden yellow to orange







FLOWER

FRUIT

light green, long, capsules containing small, hairy, silky seeds that easily blow in the wind; mature late spring/early summer
